Dear Member:

We are writing to invite you to our Lodge's Fifth Annual FOP sponsored Firearms Day on Saturday, September 17, 2011. Only current members in good standing or new members are invited. Anyone who is not a current member but wishes to shoot can fill out an application, pay next year's dues, join the Lodge, and shoot that day. We will again be holding the event at no cost to our members/prospective members. This year the Shoot will be at the Freeport New York Revolver and Rifle Range, 125 Buffalo Avenue, Freeport NY 11520. You can obtain directions from their website at [www.freeportrevolver.com](http://www.freeportrevolver.com). The use of the range is free but you must bring your own weapon, ammunition, targets, eye and ear protection. You must have at least 100 total rounds of ammunition to shoot both 50 round offered courses, and extra ammunition for the open shoot.

There will be an open shoot from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM. At 10:00 AM we will run a timed fifty shot Close Quarter's Combat course of fire for anyone wishing to participate. We will also run a fifty shot Dynamic Multiple Assailant Course following this for anyone wishing to participate. We will break for Lunch at 12 noon and have a second open shoot after lunch.

Both courses of fire are advanced courses and all participants must have passed a basic agency firearms course prior to participating. Every shooter must also sign a liability waiver to be allowed to shoot at our event. Our Lodge has developed a Close Quarters Combat (CQC) Course we will run again as this year's event. The course was developed to place the shooter in situations not addressed through basic agency firearms qualifications. There are significant shooting positions on the ground so wear clothing you don't mind getting a little/very dirty. Our Lodge has also developed a new Dynamic Multiple Assailant Course we will run for the first time this year. This course is to develop the shooter's target acquisition and firing skills for multiple simultaneous targets while moving. Individuals with revolvers can shoot both courses. We will provide targets for our CQC course and the Dynamic Multiple Assailant course. We will also send certificates to our members for completing the courses at no cost to the participants.

The Lodge will pay for food and sodas for all who attend the event. If you plan on attending please contact President Espinet (646) 836-6319 or e-mail at [Espy761@aol.com](mailto:Espy761@aol.com) and/or [Sespinet@bop.gov](mailto:Sespinet@bop.gov) so that we may get a head count of those attending.
